Wet Field Policy

This policy has been created to protect players, preserve fields and reduce maintenance. Please understand and abide by it.

1. Parks and Rec may close the fields at any time due to excess moisture.
2. Field closures will be marked by a cone on Home Plate with a sign attached.
 - a. Captains, umpires and coaches are responsible for making a reasonable decision if fields become wet after normal Parks and Rec office hours or during a contest.
3. Standing Water
 - a. Do not play on fields with standing water
 - b. Do not fill areas of standing water with any foreign material.
 - c. Do not attempt to remove areas of standing water by any means.
4. Softened Clay/Mud
 - a. If a significant footprint is left when stepping on a wet area, do not play.
